KillPasteboard XT-

I ran into this with an old Quark file we were changing to Quark 8 and wasn't sure if this was still available. I found out it was and thought I should pass it along. The KillPasteboard XT for Quark removes the Pasteboard XT that may have been embedded in the Quark file. This Pasteboard XT makes the pasteboard in Quark larger. This allows designers more room to place extra images, text boxes or anything else they may need quickly. The downside is, if you don't have this Pasteboard XT loaded in Quark than you can't open the Quark file. To remedy this, Markzware created this free Pasteboard Killer, so to speak. For those of us who don't own the Pasteboard XT, we can install this KillPasteboard XT. When the Quark file is opened, this software removes the Pasteboard XT permanently. Once this updated file is savec, anyone will now be able to open it as long as they have the correct version of Quark.
