Lead Conformity Certificate

In the somewhat short timeframe of gathering information to satisfy the requirements of the new CPSIA legislation, General Roll Leaf has pursued, to the best of it's ability, as much information as could be obtained to satisfy our customers needs regarding lead levels.

The facts we could gather from a combination of random product testing by our suppliers and information that we have received from our suppliers regarding the raw materials used in the manufacturing process, reinforce information to date that lead is not used in the manufacturing process of our hot stamping foils.

Lead Levels less than 600 ppm are required to meet the February 10, 2009 standards set by the CPSIA. Test results that we have to date indicate that lead levels in random samples of the hot stamping foils sold by General Roll Leaf are below 20 ppm and in most cases less than 10 ppm. These results indicate that the lead levels in the hot stamping foils we sell not only meet todays standards for lead levels, but the future lead limit of 300 ppm that the CPSIA is requiring as of February 10, 2009 and the lead limit 100 ppm that the CPSIA would like to attain by February 10, 2012.
